Shoal Lake 40 First Nation is undertaking a Harmonized Impact Assessment Project, incorporating *Manito Aki Inaakonigaawin* (the Great Earth Law) into the impact assessment process. To support these project, Shoal Lake 40 is looking for an Engagement Facilitator to organize community engagement sessions and events, and to keep community members informed as the projects move forward.

Responsibilities

The **Engagement Facilitator** will be responsible for:

- Facilitating community meetings to introduce, share updates, and answer questions about the project.
- Facilitating community workshops to collect knowledge on areas of significance to community members.
- Participating in site visits with Elders and community members.
- Working with the Community Coordinator to prepare for community meetings, workshops, and engagement sessions.
- Working alongside the Narratives team to prepare agendas and handout materials prior to engagements.

Qualifications and Skills

The following qualifications and skills are required:

- Experience facilitating and managing meetings, workshops and community sessions with potentially large groups of people.
- Highly organized with the ability to multitask and manage personal workload effectively.
- Experience with coordinating and scheduling.
- Member of Shoal Lake 40 First Nation.
